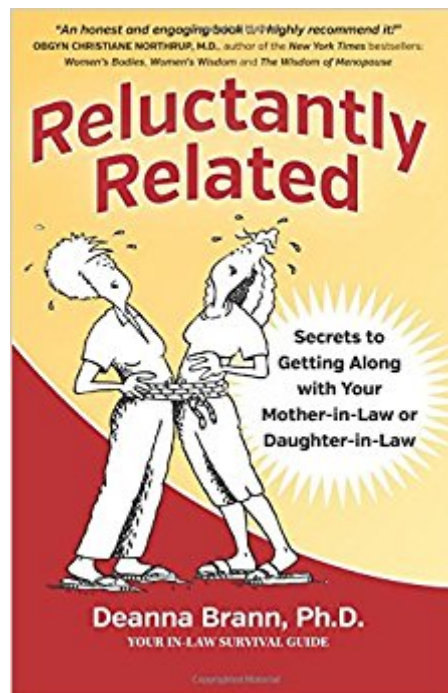




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Reluctantly Related: Secrets To Getting Along With Your Mother-in-Law Or Daughter-in-Law
