## Synopsis

Revealing pairings of a chair and a building by each architect—featuring fifty-five stars from Calatrava to Hadid—Does an architect's style always come across, regardless of medium? Pairing great buildings with great chairs by the same architect, *Chairs by Architects* demonstrates how the defining qualities of a building's style can also be evident in that architect's furniture designs. Pieces of furniture, like manifestos, become signatures of architectural style.
