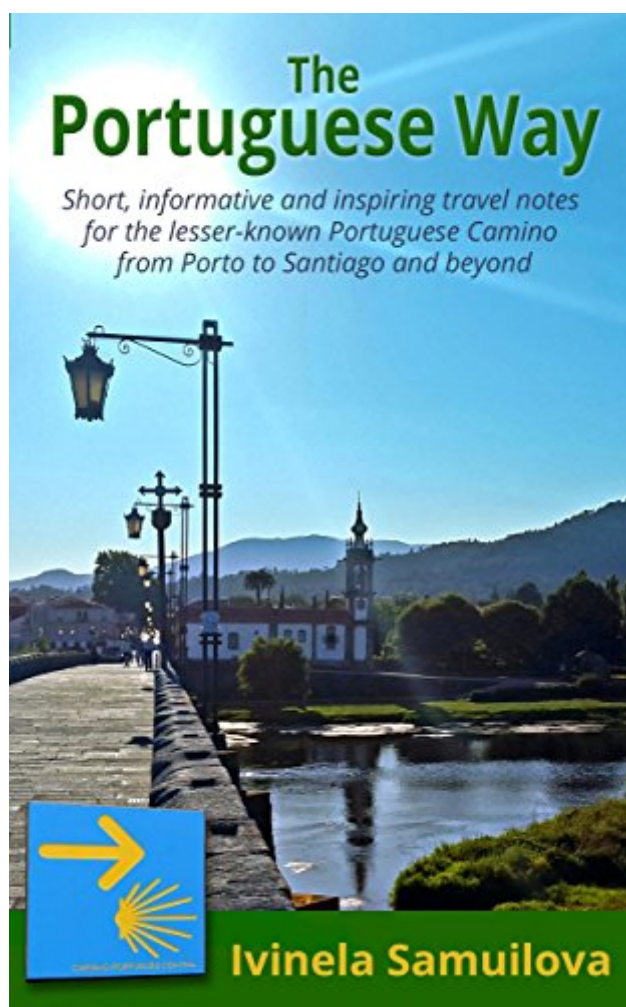


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The Portuguese Way: Short, Informative And Inspiring Travel Notes For The Lesser-known Portuguese Camino From Porto To Santiago And Beyond
