

Used this book and really no significant prior experience to frame all interior walls of an entire 1000sf third story addition at my place in Mass. The building inspector passed me first time and complimented the "framer" on his work (I hadn't told him it was me since I didn't want him to be looking for things to ding me on).

I have done lots of finish carpentry, but little framing. Of the several books I have now read seeking to learn how to properly frame a house, this is the best by a large margin. It is the most clearly written and includes the most useful practical advice.
