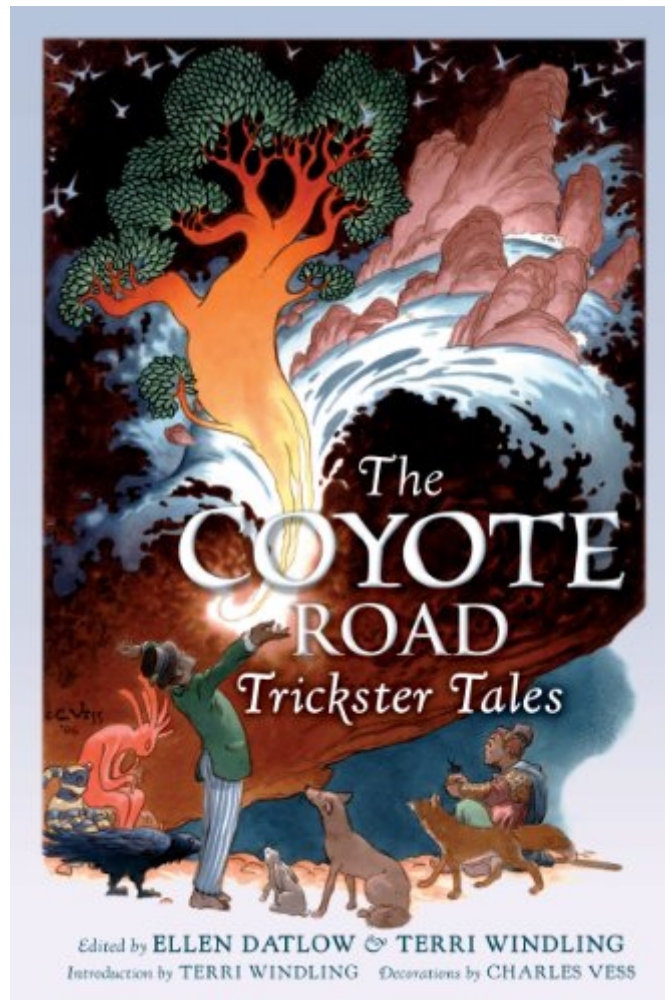




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The Coyote Road (The World Of Riverside)

Terri Windling provides a comprehensive introduction to the trickster myths of the world, and the entire book is highlighted by the remarkable decorations of Charles Vess. *The Coyote Road*, like its companions *The Green Man* (winner of the World Fantasy Award) and *The Faery Reel* (a World Fantasy Award Finalist), is essential reading for anyone interested in contemporary fantasy fiction.
