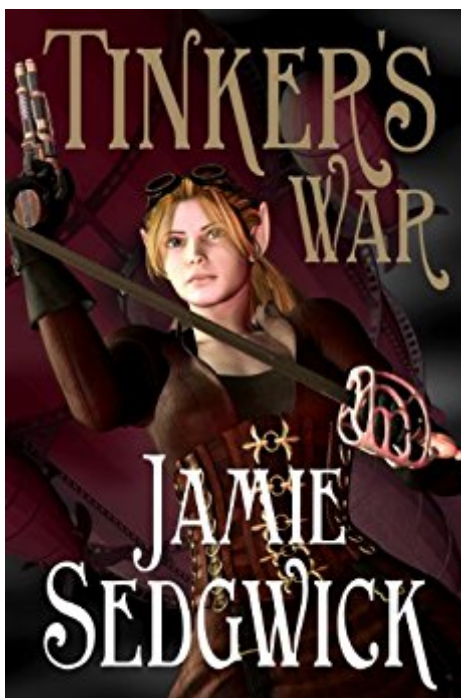

It has a compelling story that I think would appeal to both young people and older readers.
