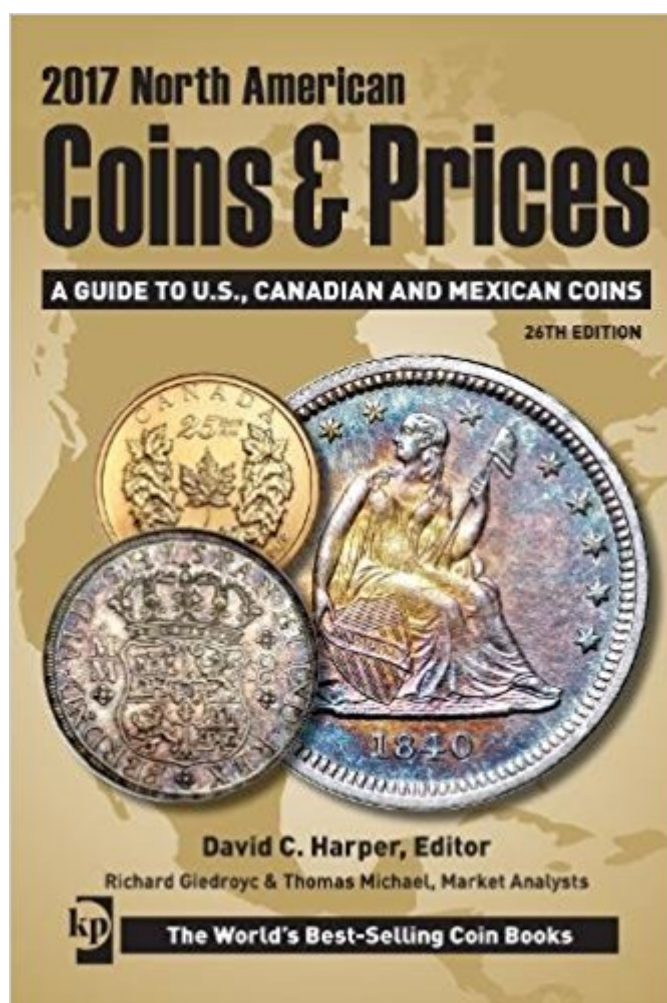

This is a far superior book to the Canadian Charleton Catalog vis a vis Canadian Coins, the latter of which has several errors and too many years presented in a non-chronological fashion. Harper's book is basically equivalent to the Yeoman red book (the Bible for US coins). So, buy this and get a twofer for a better price. As to Mexican coins, I don't collect them, but the organization appears to be fine.
