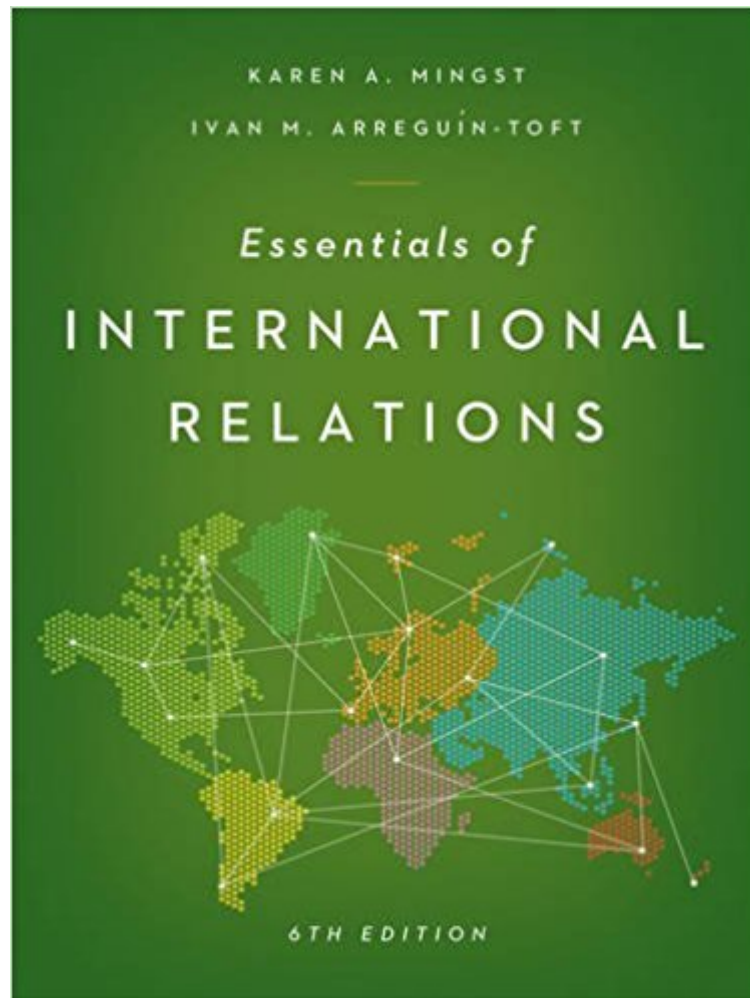




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This is THE book for international relations students. But to be honest, it is very dry and very theoretical. Good to have.
