I can not speak highly enough of this book. My drumming has improved exponentially with all of these wonderful play-alongs. In fact, these books are the reason I can comfortably play most latin styles of music when I am at jazz gigs. It has saved my life so many times, I could not imagine not using it. Bought Groove Essentials 1.0 and loved it so much that I bought 2.0 and both play along CD/book sets. As someone who has been playing drums on and off for over 20 years, I highly recommend starting with 1.0. Even if you are a drummer who has mastered Blues/Rock/Hip Hop or Jazz comping, there are so many interesting world grooves, like Soca, Calypso, Mambo, Mozambique,

etc..to keep you busy. Its opened my creative ability to try new styles outside the 4x4 rock/blues/jazz box. Unless you are already an accomplished drum teacher, I guarantee that there is something to learn in both Groove Essentials.

Book 2 certainly does not disappoint. The amazing musicians are all back and have created killer backing tracks in a cornucopia of styles. It is best to get the DVD so you understand how all the grooves should sound - it appears Tommy has had a couple shots of whiskey in this one. Whatever works. I can't imagine learning drums without these packages.

As usual, anything from Tommy is great. He has an unusual gift of teaching. Teaching drums from a recorded lesson is very difficult to pull-off...and Tommy just nails it! I think pairing this with a local drum teacher...is the best method of learning so many grooves, and keeping things organized.

Have students play along to different genre's of music in a real and practical way...with easy to read charts. And with world class musicians playing the songs.
