

This is more than JUST a bible study book for kids! this easy reader chapter book, reads like a comic book, BUT what it is teaching kids is to not only realize how much they already know about Hod, but how they can justify his existence to others! At the older elementary age, when they start questioning, this is the perfect time for this book! By using a 'crime scene' concept, J Warner lets kids discuss and formulate their own theories, in a way that they can easily understand!PLUS, there is an online component that goes along with the book, that helps both kids and their teachers/parents! Before you start reading, I would suggest that you download all the adult guides,

which can be found on the Crime Scene website, by each chapter, then download the activity sheets and notebook sheets, so that kids have them ready, as they are reading, for jotting down any applicable notes (as you can see below). Then when they finish reading the chapter, have your child go back online and view the video from J Warner, as his videos point out key information from the chapter, and offers valuable explanations and further examples, to make sure they are understanding each chapter's points. This is actually the 2nd book in the J Warner's series for kids, the first being Cold Case Christianity for Kids (which we've previously reviewed), and a 3rd book, Forensic Faith will be coming out probably next year. My 10 yr old really liked the 1st book in the series, so I know she'll love working on this one too! I will probably use it in the Spring, after we finish the one we're on now. I love that it not only gets kids reading, but has them reading their bibles, and seeing how they CAN substantiate the case for God! if you home school, you not only are covering Bible, but also Reading, Writing AND Critical thinking! you have to love a book that does all that! If you have kids who hate bible study, this just might be the book to get them back to loving it! We highly recommend it!

I didn't read or even know about the first book, "Cold-Case Christianity for Kids" is a standalone book. There will be a third book coming out, "Forensic Faith" is a standalone book. I plan on getting the first book to add to my sons reading list this coming school year. I thought that this was unique book and I loved how the author uses his background as a detective in a forensic approach to our Christian faith. The story starts out with a young cadet in a program for "Special Investigations Academy". The main character Jason hears a mystery sound up in his attic. When he goes to investigate the sounds he finds a box up in there. From there the cadets along with Alan Jeffries a detective begin an investigation into the strange box. Sounds intriguing? Well, I'm not going to give away the rest of the story. You will have to pick up your own copy. I like to think of this as a chapter book and a Bible study all in one while exploring creation. It's a fun and fast pace read that has some interesting illustrations to draw in tweens and even older elementary kids. I love that it makes the reader think and formulate their own conclusion. At the same time you are teaching your kids some critical thinking skills. Not everything is what it seems and sometimes you need to look into facts yourself and not just take something at face value. In today's world we are flooded with the media and social media with is not so Biblical thinking. The reality is that our kids need to learn how to study

God's Word and to investigate for themselves. There is also a link that you can investigate that goes along with the book. Each chapter has a video. I like that there are activity worksheets and notebook pages. The videos are well done. This is a homeschool mommas delight. I think my 11 year son will be fascinated with the fact that the author was a former detective. I know that I was extremely impressed with this book. I still haven't decided whether I want to let my son read this for himself or do it as a readout loud in our homeschool this year. I like the thought of going into this in more depth but, at the same time maybe this needs to be his own journey of discovery. Either way I would recommend this 100%.
