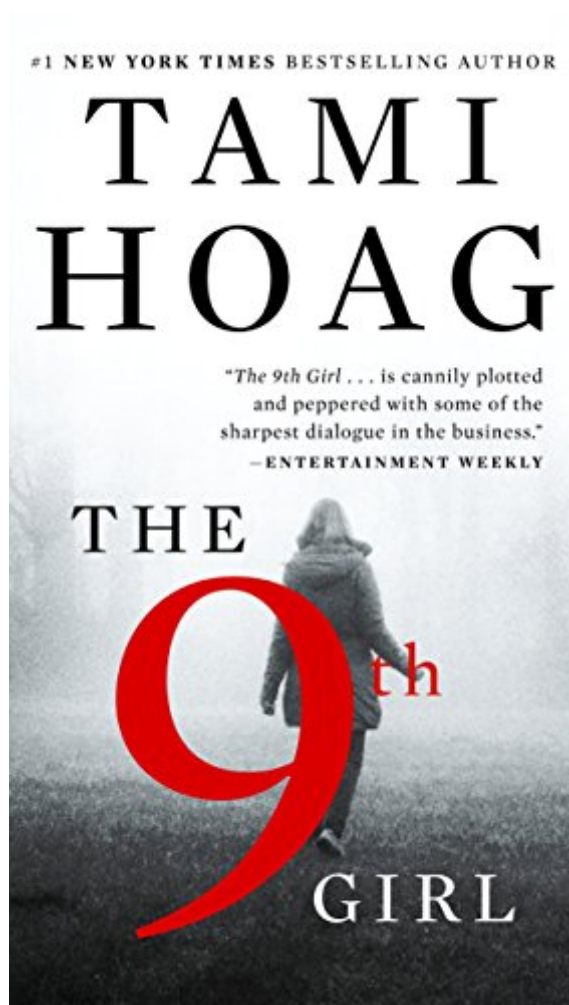


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The 9th Girl (Sam Kovac And Nikki Liska Book 4)
