

I ordered this book for a graduate level managerial accounting course. Prior to this course, I had

always been horrible at trying to decipher the steps in accounting. Needless to say, this text broke the information down in layman's terms, and I got an 'A' in the course. I was going to resell this text, but I think I may just keep it on hand for future reference.

Using this book for a master's class and thankfully it is much more explanatory than many other books I've had for graduate courses. Considering it's been many years since I've approached any type of accounting course this one doesn't force you to double up on remedial resources to grasp the subject matter. The illustrations and examples are not necessarily plentiful or repetitive as an undergrad text would be but they are clear and sufficient.

So far I like this book. I purchased the hardcover edition, so I don't know what the kindle ed is like. I have not read other books on this subject, aside from introductory accounting which I suggest you read first. But even without prerequisites, this is a solid book at 17 chapters. Short appendix and glossary. Also, take a look at the online assessments.

It explains ok. Just like most things, you have to reread and practice to really learn the concept. All the answers are in chegg in case y'all need to double check your work.

The book is well written and will add to your class. If you can get this as a rental I would suggest it as this is not one of the books I will keep to go back to as a reference. Once you have your formulas down you won't need to open this book again.
