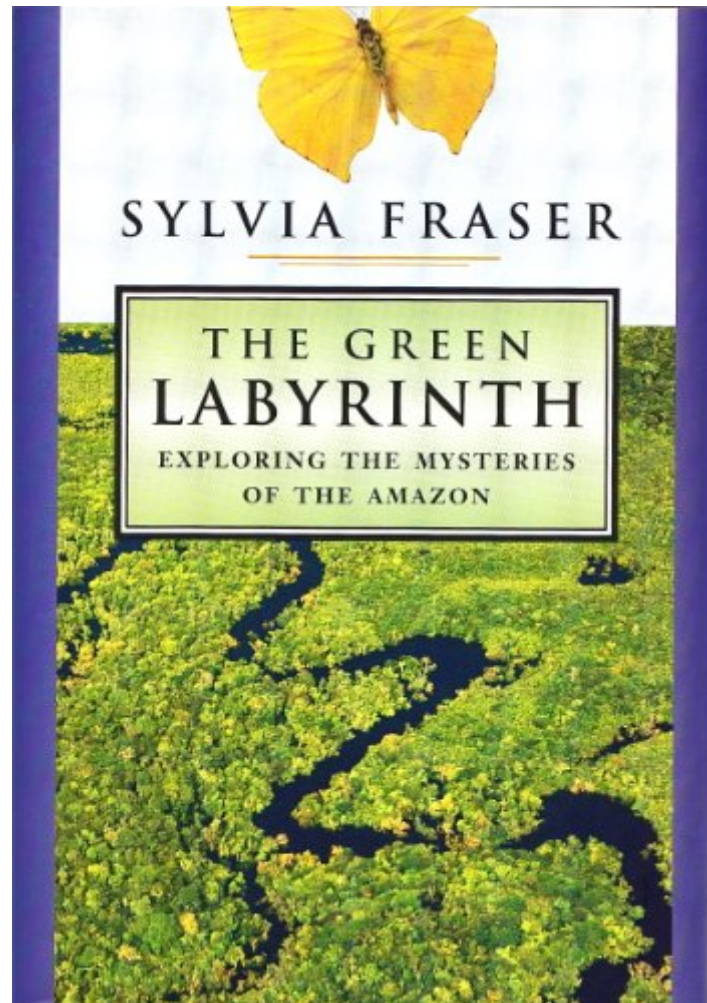

Synopsis

What risks would you take if they allowed you to enjoy superpowers, or to gain insights that would transform your life? That was the question Sylvia Fraser asked herself after reading reports of pioneering scientists who testified that drinking the psychoactive plant medicine ayahuasca, found in the Amazon jungles, allowed them to "run like pumas and fly like eagles." They were not merely hallucinating, they claimed, but undergoing mind-expanding, life-changing journeys into other dimensions of reality where the usual laws of physics did not rule. Evidence for the power of ayahuasca also lay in the fact that Amazon shamans, whose ancestors had been drinking ayahuasca for generations, had discovered many of the most potent pharmaceuticals in use today by Western doctors. When shamans were asked how they came up with these sophisticated medicines, they replied, "Ayahuasca told us." Though Fraser had never experimented with psychedelics, she decided to travel to the Amazon to experience ayahuasca for herself and to learn the healing wisdom of the shamans. With Fraser as our guide, we visit tribal sanctuaries that hover at the edge of our modern world, where she ingests ayahuasca in eight ceremonies, propelling her on sometimes terrifying but always illuminating journeys into the unknown that force her to reassess Western concepts of what is "real." We also climb Machu Picchu, legendary mountain fortress of the Incas to visit the Sky Gods, then travel through Peru's coastal desert to see the ancient Nazca line drawings so impressive in scale and artistry that they have been popularly attributed to aliens. En route, we meet various Peruvian teachers, happy to share the mysteries of their ancient cultures, along with a diverse group of fellow questers.
