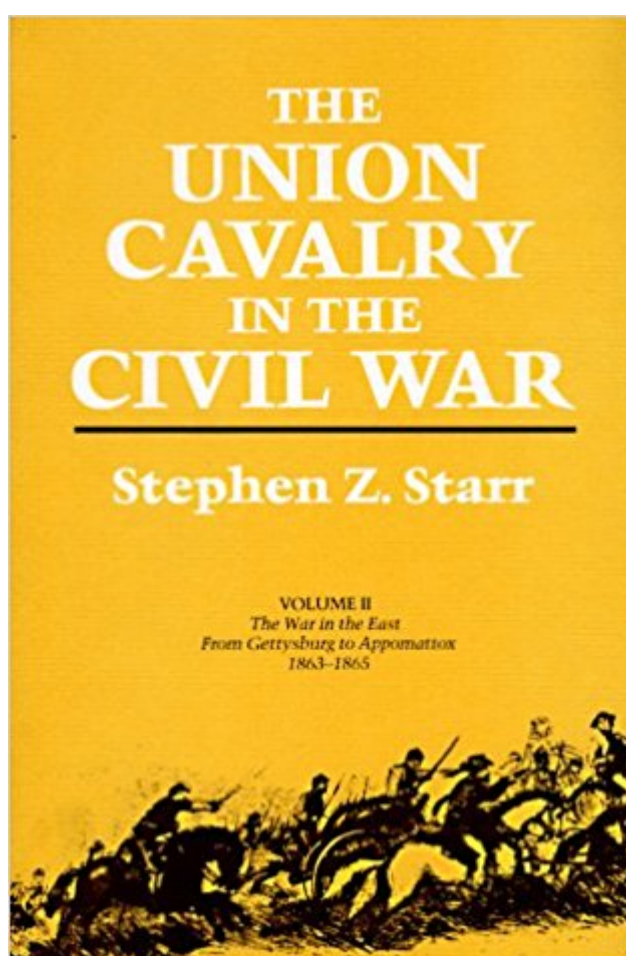


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Union Cavalry In The Civil War, Vol. 2: The War In The East, From Gettysburg To Appomattox, 1863-1865
