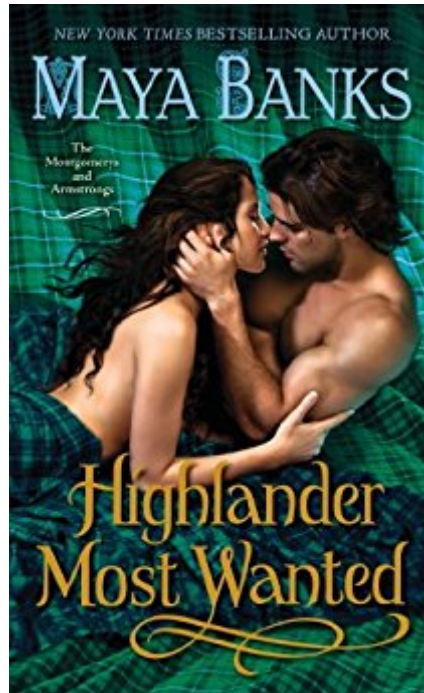

This was a great follow up to Never Seduce a Scot. I completely fell love with Bowen because he care and compassion for Genevieve. As stated in some of the reviews, it does have some harsh subject matter, such as rape and abuse that the characters must over come. Obviously, this book has HEA theme, so the author did have to inflict some 21st century themes in order to develop a plot to get to the ending. Some people criticized some of the historical accuracy of the times, I am more about the overall story. Since I am looking for some great steamy characters with an interesting story, I am not evaluating too much historical accuracy. I have read several Scottish romances over the years and there was enough accuracy to make the story real. The author does a great job bringing me back in time. I loved this book. I can't wait for her next installment. I did listen to the audio narration to this book and the narrator was fabulous.

I was anticipating this book as I really liked the first one in this group, however I must say I was greatly disappointed. I felt like the plot was uneven and at times confusing. The story involved a woman who had been sexually and mentally abused and yet she headed into a relationship with the hero without any problems. I get we are talking an imaginary story here but it still needs to have some kind of realistic responses from characters to make it a plot that readers can relate to and not shake their heads. This writer has impressed me so much in the past that I was genuinely surprised by this effort.

This is a very good Highlander romance, with a likeable couple. Her story was very sad, and brought me to tears several times -- but it was sweet how he saved her and didn't blame her for what had happened. This book does include sex scenes and quite a bit of violence, so if that bothers you, it is not for you. But if you like Highlander romances that are true to the time period, this is a very good one.

These two books are my favorite of all time. I didn't think anything could follow the first book. But

this is the perfect way to wrap things up. This is the second or third time I've read these books. Every few years I get the urge to read them again. I laugh and cry all over again.

This book was depressing. I loved the first book in this series and was happy when this one came out, until I started reading it. I hate when an author puts rape in a romance novel, that's the last thing you want to think about when reading a love story. I know there needs to be some kind of drama to overcome in these books to move the story along and get the main characters together but I really wish Maya Banks could have thought of something else. The story had a good ending but it was hard to get there, and the overall story just made me sad.

First I will say the plot had me excited about reading this book and secondly I was so disappointed after reading it. As for a woman who had been kidnapped from her family who presumed she was dead and for the next year she is abused, raped (and not just from her captor) and led a degrading life from all the clan during that time; I can not believe for one minute she would fall for anyone so quickly and move into a relationship with them. As for myself, the last thing I would want is for another man to touch me or consume my life. I understand things are a lot different in that time period but let's be real, women in that time would commit suicide after that kind of abuse just not to relive it over and over. Story was lacking and there was too much repeat information to fill the book with so many pages. I did however enjoy the first book in this series and I am looking forward to the third.

This second book in the series was nowhere near as good as the first one, in my opinion. I liked Genevieve as the heroine, she had a tragic story and I was rooting for her to stand up for herself and find happiness. Unfortunately she never did really fight back against the clan after they basically terrorized and abused her, Bowen instead just took her away, which worked just as well. I'm giving it 3 stars because I really did not connect with the hero at all. There was no character development of Bowen, we didn't hear about his backstory or any emotions other than him admiring Genevieve for what she had been through and then falling in love with her because of it (and very quickly). It was a decent story and Maya Banks is a good writer, this one just felt a bit rushed and I didn't care whether they got together or not. Looking forward to the next one and hoping it will be better.

This is the second book in the Montgomery and Armstrong series. I really enjoyed the heroine, Genevieve McInnis, in this novel. She was abducted, raped and abused for an entire year at the

hands a madman but somehow her spirit was not broken. She is a sweet, strong lass that was in dire need of a champion and protector. And that champion came in the form of the handsome warrior, Bowen Montgomery. Although Genevieve stole the show, Bowen was a wonderful hero with the right blend of sexy and sensitive. Because of his love and dedication, the heroine was able overcome the terribly traumatic events in her life. This was a feel good story that left me with a smile on my face. The only negative is that the book ended abruptly. As soon as they H/h got together, it ended. I would have liked more story, more of a wrap up. An epilogue would have been great. The ending felt incomplete.
