

Having to cram for a huge test is never a fun experience, but this book made that tons easier. Most of its information was concise and easy to digest. Other books like this I've used in the past have been very wordy and super super dry. I also like how there's a handy summary of the main points at the end in case you didn't feel like actually reading the chapter. The answers to the questions are also thorough and make sense to me. There was also a helpful vocabulary/glossary section which was useful to refer to when I wasn't sure of a word they were referring to in a section of this book. The tips helped a lot too and I don't regret at all purchasing this book!

It was late in the school year, about April, when I finally caved and decided to get a prep book for the AP US History exam. That gave me roughly a month to study, and soon I was spending just about every hour outside of school hunched over this prep book, skimming my allotted section for the day. This book is great because it had many vocab terms which I used to create 340 term flashcard set, and it also had quizzes that I could use to check my knowledge. For the time pressed like me, it was great because I could go to the back of the section and do the quiz before reading it, and if I did well on the quiz, then I knew that I didn't have to read that section. It saved me a lot of time. Also, the sections were not terribly long, and I did manage to read several of them before I began compulsively skimming them. It even had a plan in it for people like me who only decide to study when they realize the test is in a month. It was worth it, and the title does not lie, as I did get a 5.

My son followed this book in preparation for the AP test and scored well. The book matches the AP test pretty closely in format. I would stress that having the discipline to use the book correctly and regularly is important.

Great book! Has really great information and was super helpful for preparing for the exam! In my opinion this book is quite detailed, and can't be read through completely in the days before the exam, but is better reviewing specific periods. If you are looking for a cramming book I would
