It was a slow start, but still an interesting read Lady Imogen is looking forward to the London Season for one reason and one reason only: to secure funding for her and Lady Redmond's charity. Heath is an Earl who is as selfish as his mother. When they meet Imogen takes an instant dislike to him because he mocks her cause. Heath wants to teach her lessons but it is he who is taught a lesson in the end. Heath and Imogen find themselves becoming attracted to each other, but fight it. Heath because he doesn't understand the changes in himself and Imogen because she doesn't want to have give up her charity. The plot thickens when other people get involved to keep them apart. Will the other people succeed? Will Heath and Imogen be together? Will Imogen get her charity?

Heath Montgomery, the Earl of Reddington has been fortunate to live a life of shallow idleness and security. I liked this story. The protagonists are well-developed and evolve, not one-dimensional. Not so much with the antagonists, who status-driven like most of the "evil characters" in regency romances. It is well-edited, though I stumbled over some typos at locations 62, 1031, and 2650 (wrong title!). The main thing that kept me from giving it 5 stars is the length of some of the discussions between Imogen and Adeline. Honestly, I thought their discussion at the beginning of the book would never end! I find it hard to jump right into a conversation with two unfamiliar characters, especially one that is trying to do so much at the outset of the story.

This is entertaining, dramatic and romantic. Heath is pompous, snarky and shallow until he meets

Imogen. She fascinates him and opens his eyes. Imogen is caring, sweet and somewhat naive.. Heath raises her hackles immediately upon meeting him. Heath's mother is pushing him to marry an egotistical witch of a woman, who he initially finds agreeable. But the more he learns about Imogen, the more he likes her. Add in a creepy Duke who decides that he wants Imogen and you get lots of drama. I received a complimentary copy of this book from Hidden Gems. This is my voluntary and honest opinion of it.

During the London Season (a time of balls and parties galore for the upper echelon) two ladies start a charitable fund raising campaign in hopes of opening a shelter to help the needy. They use the parties to appeal to the wealthy for donations. A delightful story of the haves and the have nots, the Earl's and the Duke's and changing attitudes.

I loved this great story with great characters, romance and intrigue. His mother was terrible as were the girl and her father and the duke. They all got what they deserved. The ending was great. I can't wait to read more books from this author. I voluntarily reviewed an advance reader copy and highly recommend it to lovers of this genre.
