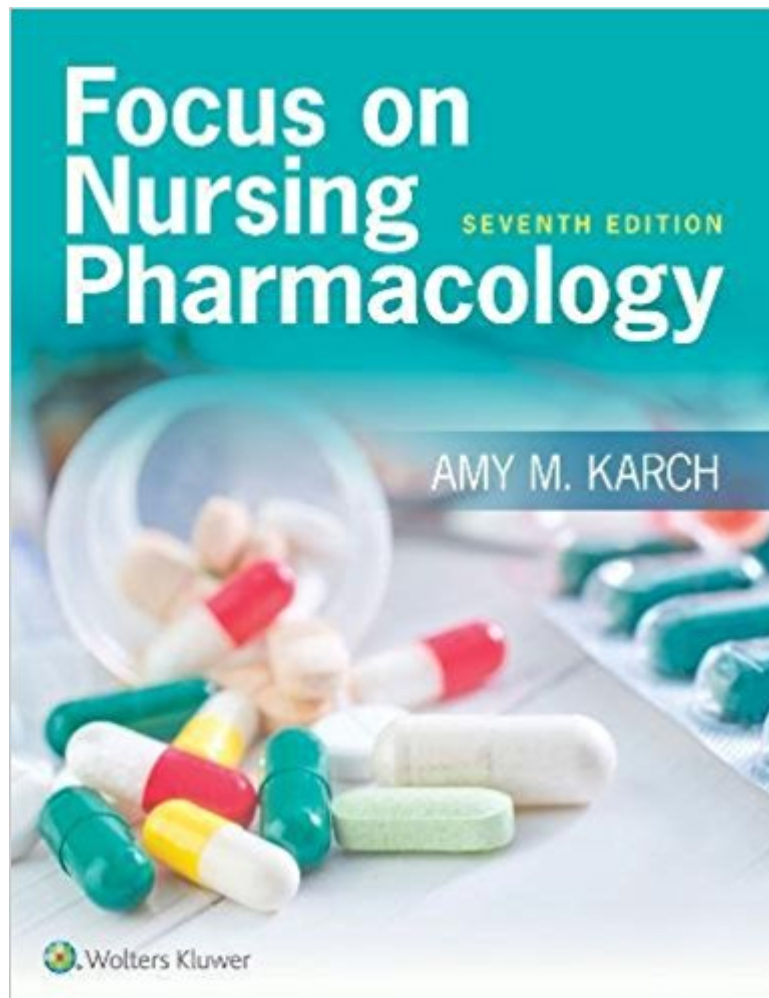

I was at first in love with this book but my nursing cohort and I have found NUMEROUS errors! Just to list two: On page 437 it lists Triptans as, "selective serotonin receptor blockers" when they are actually agonists (the opposite of a blocker) and on page 432 there is a whole section on direct-acting skeletal muscle relaxants but it was mislabeled as centrally-acting skeletal muscle relaxants (big difference). I am telling you, TONS of errors! It really is unfortunate though because I do think the book offers the material in a very simplistic form and I absolutely LOVE the chapters where it explains the pathophysiology of the system prior to introducing the drugs that affect it. I guess this book was rushed to the printing process and they completely skipped the editing process. The information is untrustworthy and I would not recommend buying it :-)
