

Mattson does a masterful job of weaving in details of Quranic teachings and the relationship that Muslims have with the Quran into a single narrative. The first two chapters are also among the best available literature for understanding the life of the Prophet Muhammad. Chapters three and four are a masterful presentation of the variegated ways in which the Quran penetrates Islamic life. Chapter five provides an excellent account of the manner in which the polyvalent nature of the Quran has led to multiple interpretive strands. The final chapter conveys the majesty of the relationship between the individual believer and the word of God. More than an introduction to the Quran, this book is an introduction to Islam and an all-important window into the heart of the most widely read book in the world.
