

This book exceeded my expectations on every level. It is written by a serious author who clearly researched his subject and has not allowed himself to be corrupted by revisionist history or political correctness. The photographs are large and beautifully reproduced; every detail the author refers to is plainly visible. The text is reserved and restrained, but contains a wealth of information and detail.
