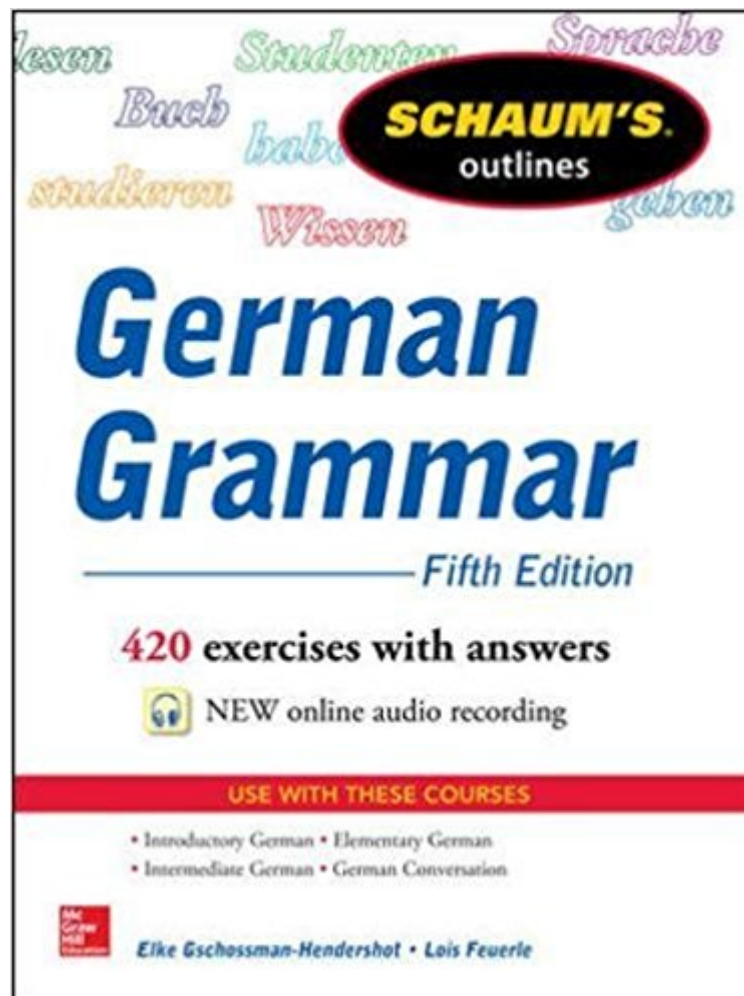

Great reference for subjects being learned as well as a refresher for things learned that have been

forgotten. Other posters have said that this book isn't really for beginners; however, I am a beginner and I have found it to be a very helpful reference. I'm guessing that its value might be related to 'what' level of a beginner you are. If you are just starting to learn German (as in just starting this week), you may not find it helpful. But I would say after a couple of weeks you begin to see value in it. The only problem I've had so far is getting the link emailed to me from the McGraw-Hill website. I've tried 3 or 4 times over the last month to get the link sent and even though the website says it was sent I never receive it. I even emailed MH customer service with the email address I was using, and as of yet I haven't seen the link or had a response from McGraw-Hill.

I picked up a copy of this book for Kindle with a specific purpose in mind. I needed something that could go into depth about the different cases used in German grammar, and it does this very well. It's a lot better than other books that I have purchased of this type. The others spend about a paragraph on the topic, and this book gives much more than that. It is very thorough and provides many examples. I don't know about the print version, but the Kindle version is very well organized. It has in-text links to other portions of the book when needed, and the table of contents is a breeze to navigate.

Learning anything is a slow, iterative and incremental process requiring patience application and support by quality learning material and method. Schaum's Outline of German Grammar provides such method and material. I found it well organised with both, introduction of new topics and accompanying exercises. Grammatical concepts are well explained with generous comparisons to English usage. I attend German classes at Goethe Institute and I found Schaum's Outline as an excellent supporting material.

This is a good overview of German grammar, as far as anything can be. It's a complex thing to slog through and has been useful mainly by working on small sections at a time and trying to tie that into reading and work in other books. It would be hard and probably unproductive for any student to read this cover to cover. I did find some odd things like lists of examples of a particular case that include sentences that don't really illustrate that case, either because they just don't or because they have a case where a pronoun or noun does not change case so it doesn't serve as a good example. But on the whole the book does a good job shedding at least some light on the complexity of German grammar.

This is not a complete teaching tool, but it's a great review/drill add-on. I am teaching myself and my biggest problem was drilling myself and not knowing whether or not I was right. Every drill has an answer.
