

The original version of the book was given to me as a gift and totally changed my gardening direction forever. Yes, I live in the south, and these old chinas, teas, noisettes, etc. are covered well, and some with a hint into their history. This book helped to 'set the hook' for my future purchases/obsession of not only the old roses but all roses in general. It also showed me the advantages of growing roses on their own roots. This book has had updates from the original but overall I think it's just about the same. Great book for intro into the antique roses but as the title says, 'for the south...

The good news is that this book identifies antique roses that are not seen that often and has some very good pictures of them. There is also some interesting discussion about how some of these roses were found and identified by hobbyists. The bad news is that I was expecting a lot more information on husbandry. For example, there are only two pages in the book dedicated to growing

antique roses in containers, but there are no less than 52 pages (about half the narrative of the book, discounting the rose list in the back) dedicated to indoor flower arrangements with roses, drying and preserving roses in displays, etc., which has absolutely no interest to me. I'd recommend this book as a supplemental reference on antiques, relying on other sources for care information.

Dr Welch is an expert and any information he provides is so helpful and accurate.
