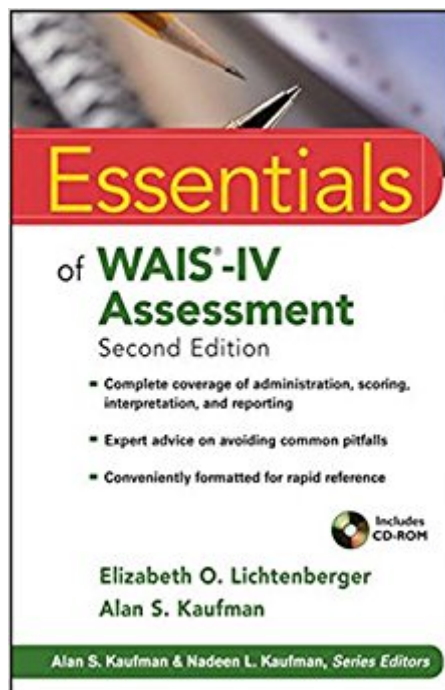

This is a concise and concrete how-to manual based on the Wechsler Adult scales. The CD provides packaged/"canned" test protocols so as to get up and running with adult intelligence testing without having to reinvent the wheel. This is a useful adjunct to the far more comprehensive studies required in conducting Neuropsychological Evaluations, which are directed to ferreting out the Neurobiological (Cerebral) basis of Cognitive Abnormalities. It's also worthwhile to have several of the other texts in this series (also authored by the Kaufmans), so as to avail oneself of other, purely PSYCHOLOGICAL test methodologies. MBT, MDMBT, MD
