

I was hoping that she would write more about this spiritual help she received later in the book, but she didn't. The stories about one particular friend who caused her anguish and the stories about her homes became tedious for me. The one very positive note in her memoir is her supportive husband--he was the bright spot in an otherwise rather bleak story.
