

Oh the feels in this book! House of Ravens is the second book in the Nightfall Chronicles and it picks up right where Court of Nightfall left off. Classes are about to start at Castle V and Scarlett finally meets her new roommate (and her roommate's brothers more on that later). Her "normal" life is looking up; she has her biff

Jax, her new friends Corinne, Wyat, and Kai, and classes aren't too bad. As Nightfall, things aren't so rosy but she is dealing, and learning to function as two people. Just when things are heating up with Jax, he leaves her for reasons unknown. No worries, the void is filled with Prince Kai the beautiful and kind brother of her roommate. Just when things seem at their best, Scarlett is forced to make the hardest decision of her life and everything collapses for her (insert sobbing here). Even though this book has a horrible moment that you will hate (no spoilers!) it is still done beautifully and is well worth every moment you spend immersed in the world that KK has built. Even the sad parts are so important to the overall story you cannot help but forgive and I can't wait for the rest of the story!

The Story Continues.....Scarlett has a roommate she wasn't expecting, the Princess of the House of Ravens, no less! She and her two brothers are also students at Castle V. With her nightly rounds to do at the Cathedral, she wasn't exactly thrilled to having a roommate, it was hard enough to leave and enter at odd hours of the day and night! Much happens in this book, but instead of just listing all the updates, I think you should read the book yourself, after reading the first Nightfall Chronicles book, "Nightfall Court". I always try to read the books in a series in order.....Good advice if you are new at this.

This continuation of the Nightfall saga grips your heart and holds onto you from beginning to end. I appreciate a heroine with both strength and flaws. Scarlet's strength of character, will, intelligence and even her heart are well depicted throughout this book. Much of her strength comes not only from inside herself but also from the friends with whom she surrounds herself. Her weaknesses, ignorance of certain areas and more are also seen. I fell in love with several of the characters. My heart warming and breaking with the ups and downs. This is truly a journey and it has left me on the edge of my seat waiting for more!

She's a student of the Orders but she's also Nightfall. While Scarlett struggles with Orders training and being a symbol for change against the wrongs done to the church she meets her prince charming. Can she serve more than one master? Will she be able to balance fighting the system without compromising her morals and ideals?

I really like this series because it's like having three books in one. And the story continually evolves into its own unique tale with surprisingly unexpected twists. If you loved books like Hunger Games, Mortal Instruments and Divergent, you will fall in-love with The Nightfall Chronicles. Angels, Nephilim, and Templars populate the story characters along with Zeniths, Fairies and of course humans. N or Nightfall and heroine, aka, Scarlett begins to discover who she has become in book 1 and falls in-love in book 2. But wait that's not all, she creates life, too, along with fighting to pursue social justice. Three for one, and one for all!
