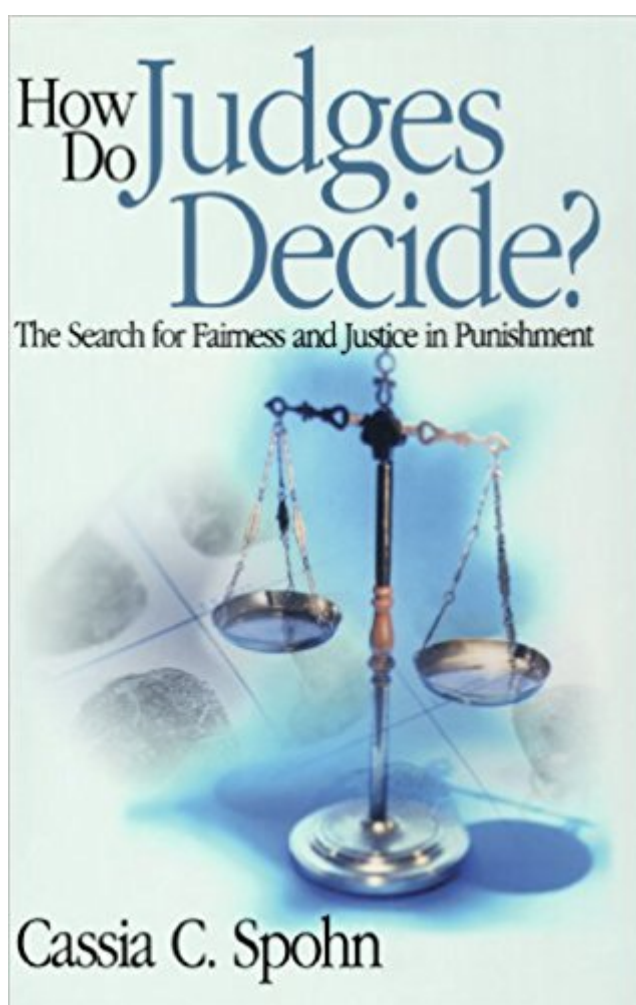


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How Do Judges Decide?: The Search For Fairness And Justice In Punishment (Key Questions For Criminal Justice)
