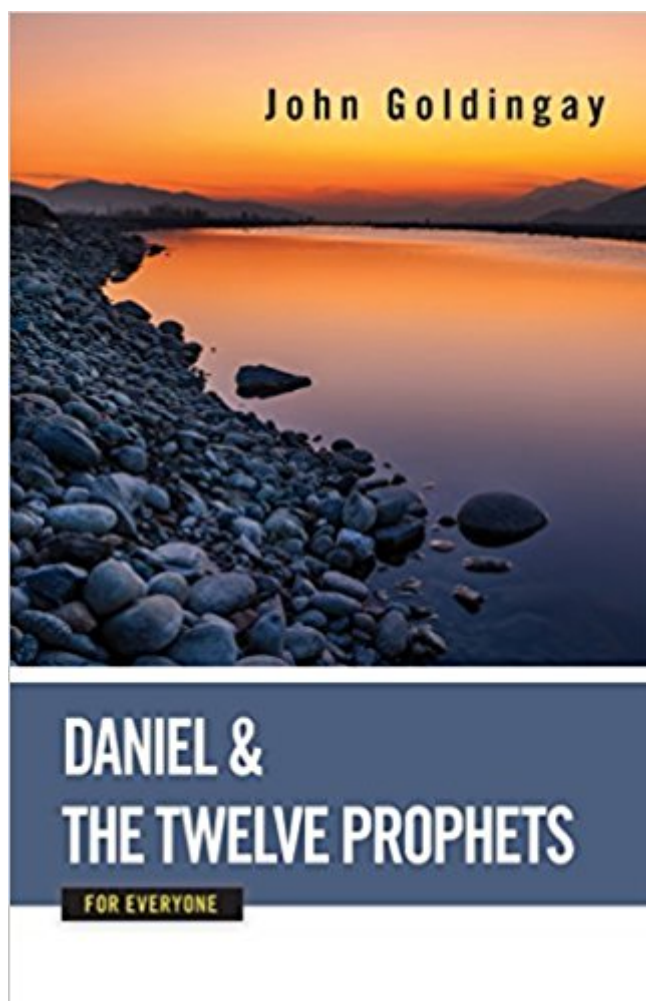


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Daniel And The Twelve Prophets For Everyone



Synopsis

In the Old Testament for Everyone series, Old Testament scholar John Goldingay addresses Scripture from Genesis to Malachi in such a way that even the most challenging passages are explained simply and concisely. The series is perfect for daily devotions, group study, or personal visits with the Bible. In this final volume of the series, Goldingay covers Daniel and the Minor Prophets, the final twelve prophetic books of the Old Testament. Daniel is an apocalyptic book, full of ideas about God's plan for the end of the earth and humanity. The twelve Prophets—Hosea through Malachi—were shorter prophetic works that could be kept on a single scroll and address the period of massive change in the eastern Mediterranean in the 8th century BCE.

Excellent and Scholarly introduction to Daniel and the "Minor Prophets"

The Commentaries for Everyone series offers readers an introduction to the books of the Bible via scholarly expositions painting the big pictures of Scripture. The books also delve into particular

insights along the way. The commentaries consist of thorough and faithful, orthodox perspectives. They are suited for individual study, small group discussions and can contribute to sermon preparation and academic writing. Daniel and the Twelve Prophets for Everyone is written by John Goldingay, Professor of Old Testament at Fuller Theological Seminary and author of many commentaries on Old Testament Biblical books. After a brief introduction of Daniel and the twelve prophetic books, Goldingay launches into his commentaries. He includes his own translations of all of the Biblical texts prior to each section of commentary writing. He writes that his translations align with the literal Hebrew more than other translations. This is proved true in comparisons to other published translations. The author's translations of text and his commentary make up about equal portions of the book. His pattern is to efficiently get to the heart of the matter in the commentaries and to elaborate on highlights he wants to emphasize. His commentary includes personal reflections and anecdotes from his personal, family and vocation history. He often begins sections with a reflection from contemporary life to bring the Biblical context to light. This pattern makes the book more appealing for laypeople but might seem obtrusive to scholars. Readers will find a helpful, orthodox reading of Scripture that does account for mysteries of authorship, dates and literal versus allegorical narratives. This commentary can offer a helpful resource for those reading through these books in their own devotional time, leading or participating in groups. Any of the books in the series would also be fitting for library shelves.

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
