

Among Dr. Foster's areas of expertise are strategic quality planning, service quality, Six Sigma, government quality, and the role of technology in improving quality. Tom is the Donald L. Staheli Professor of quality and global supply chain management in the Marriott School of Management at Brigham Young University. He has also taught at Pennsylvania State University and Boise State University. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Missouri-Columbia. A Dr.

Foster has professional experience in manufacturing, financial services operations, and international oil exploration. He has consulted for over 30 companies, including Trus Joist MacMillan, the U.S. Department of Energy, Hewlett-Packard, Heinz Frozen Food, and Cutler Hammer/Eaton Corporation. Dr. Foster currently serves on the 12-person Board of Overseers for the Malcolm Baldrige Award and has served as a judge for state awards. Tom is on the editorial boards of the Journal of Operations Management, the Quality Management Journal, and Decision Sciences. He has published over 80 quality-related research articles in journals such as The Journal of Operations Management, Decision Sciences, the International Journal of Production Research, the Quality Management Journal, and Quality Progress. He is listed in Who's Who in America and Who's Who in the World. Dr. Foster is founder of www.freequality.org, was awarded the ASBSU Outstanding Faculty Award, and served as guest editor for the Journal of Operations Management and Quality Management Journal special issue on supply chain quality. In addition, he was winner of the 2002 Decision Sciences Institute Innovative Education Award. Foster is co-author of Managing Supply Chain and Operations from Pearson. I got this book as required text for a graduate management class. It does have a lot of useful information, especially with statistic's graphing in Excel, but the book is just difficult to read. Also, no where does it list that this book is an 'exclusive edition for the benefit of students outside the United States and Canada.' I am extremely concerned over this information especially since it is directly printed on the softcover of the book. I would not have ordered the softcover if this information would have been available to me upfront. has done a poor job prepresenting this option of book for sale. I am very disappointed in this and feel like I just had a 'bait and switch' pulled on me. I have not 'opened' the book yet, because I do not know what to expect as in if the pages are numbered the same as the hardcover or not. Again, I am very disappointed in the information on
