

Years ago, doctors and therapists were discouraged from talking to teenagers about suicide for fear the conversation would trigger an impulse in the youngster to kill himself. That was long ago, and now therapists routinely ask adolescent clients about suicidal thoughts and attempts. This book by Dr. Ron Salomon goes one step further - it actively educates high school students about the causes, the warning signs, and the treatment of suicidality. Dr. Salomon encourages teenagers to be aware of warning signs of suicide in their friends and classmates and, of course, to reach out for help. His book demystifies the topic by explaining some of the biological and psychosocial causes of suicide.
