

E.G. FOLEY is the pen name for a husband-and-wife writing team who live in Pennsylvania. They've been finishing each other's sentences since they were teens, so it was only a matter of time till they were writing together, too. Like his kid readers, "E" (Eric) can't sit still for too long! A bit of a renaissance man, he's picked up hobbies from kenpo to carpentry to classical guitar over the years, and holds multiple degrees in math, science, and education. He treated patients as a chiropractor for nearly a decade, then switched careers to venture into the wild-and-woolly world of teaching middle school, where he was often voted favorite teacher. His students helped inspire him to start dreaming up great stories for kids, until he recently switched gears again and left teaching to become a full-time writer and author entrepreneur. By contrast, "G" (Gael, aka Gaelen Foley) has had one dream all her life and has pursued it with maniacal intensity since the age of seventeen: writing fiction! After earning her Lit degree at SUNY Fredonia, she waited tables at night for nearly six years as a "starving artist" to keep her days free for honing her craft, until she finally got The Call in 1997. Today, with millions of her twenty-plus romances from Ballantine and HarperCollins sold in many languages worldwide, she's been hitting bestseller lists regularly since 2001. Although she loves all her readers, young and old, she admits there's just something magical about writing for children. I read this book in less than a day. It is very easy reading with none of the proofreading errors that I run in to so often. The hero is 12 years old and is just coming in to his magic powers and finding out about his evil uncle. He also uncovers some more palatable relatives, and all's well that ends well. There are just enough loose ends to lead in to another part of the story, but this one could easily

stand alone. Characters are well-drawn and the situations are believeable.

This book is really a great read. Without revealing too much, it's about a orphan boy who's family has been searching for him, eventually find him and his introduction into their magical world. There are some interesting twist involving an evil family member, magic and of course magical creatures. I love the main character jake. He is kind of witty and sarcastic at times. I think that all the characters could use a little more development which would give the book a more unique feel. All in all it is well written and really a fun read. The Lost Heir by E. G. Foley is a fast paced fantasy set in Victorian England during Queen Victoria's 50th year. Jake, an orphan, thief, and scalawag discovers he has several magical talents: he can see ghosts and perform telekinesis. His best friend, Dani, discourages him from using these powers. Hard-headed Jake won't listen. And then a purloined mince-pie tosses him head-first into an unexpected series of adventures that will change their lives forever.

I was bored. To be honest I didn't even finish it even though I got more than half way through. Just didn't feel the urge to keep up with the story. I didn't care about the characters and I know the main character is a kid, but the writing made him so just so juvenile. I guess that's fine because it's a children's book, but Harry Potter didn't bug me like that.

I enjoyed reading this book, but it took concentration to figure out the occasional word in the Queen's English that did not mean the same in American English. But the story proceeded well, the characters were sympathetic and the writing was mostly well done.
