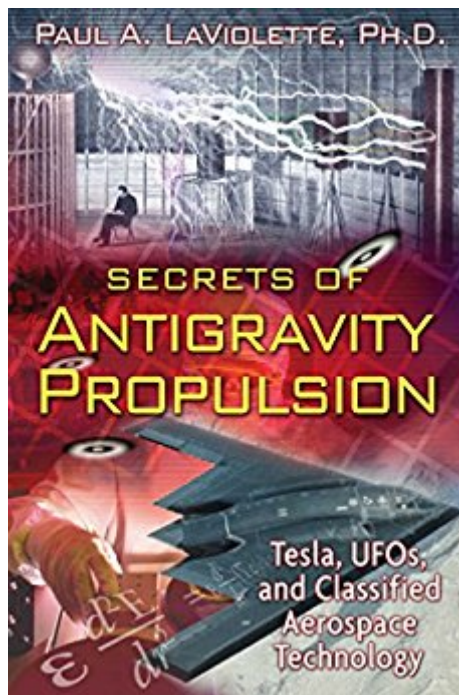

I have been interested in Anti Gravity propulsion from an early age. This book enables the layman not involved in classified projects insight into technology that has been evolving since the 1950's. There is a section regarding Nickola Tesla. Most information available on Tesla has been purposefully suppressed and is limited. Dr. Laviolette does a great job explaining the physical concepts described in this book. I came away with a good understanding of how this technology works. This is a great book for anyone interested in the potential positive future for humanity. I read this book prior to reading "Where did the Towers go" by Dr. Judy Wood. The insight that I gained from reading this book has given me a new perspective in many aspects of life. This book should be required reading for all students and parents.

This book covers a broad area of science and engineering to sufficient depth to leave this reader, educated in the field, to question the common truths that form the foundation of our technological society today. As a practicing microwave and communications systems engineer, I marvel of our creations from our knowledge of electricity and magnetism and yet it remains a mystery why we have not mastered gravity and engineered it the same degree as E&M. LaViolette builds a strong case for the likelihood that the knowledge is in fact present, but is simply not accessible to the broader society. Shining a blight light on dark places tends to displace the mold and mildew that tends to rot things. There appear to be many more dark corners in our world that is in need of lighting.

After the first few chapters it's a difficult read, because it gets increasingly technical. But I've read

enough to be astounded and adds further to my believe that most of the UFO's sighted throughout the years did not come from outer space. I bought this because I was interested in T. Townsend Brown's work, and look forward to reading the chapter on Searle Effect.
