

PHOEBE DUNN was a world-renowned photographer best known for her pictures of children and animals. Her photographs have been published in more than twenty children's books, many of them written by her daughter, Judy Dunn.

This review is not pertaining to whether I enjoyed this book or not (I absolutely loved it as a child), it is only in relation to the contents of the Board Book. I wanted to make sure everyone is aware that the Board Book is severely edited, and is NOT the same as the original version of the book. It contains approximately half of the text and pictures of the paperback version, and in my opinion is

missing many of the best photos. From the posting online, it is not necessarily clear that the Board Book is edited/ does not contain all of the original book contents, and had I have known that I would not have purchased it.

This was one of my favorite books as a child. I would spend hours pouring over the pictures. The photos of the duck hatching are amazing yet simple. Children alway laugh with the blow drying of the duck, I was very pleased to find this book as an adult and to be able to share this book with my 5 and 1 year old who both equally enjoy it. The pictures are classic late seventies/ early eighties. Very sweet nostalgia for parents. I used this book as a gift for all the guest at my daughters first birthday.

This is one of many wonderful Judy Dunn books -- we first got "The Little Kitten" (Pictureback(R)) and couldn't wait to find more. These are simple, sweet stories that accompany adorable, clear photography of children with their pets. If you've read a lot of books with your kids, you'll understand that not all are created equal. These are head and shoulders above MANY others -- No dorky rhymes, no annoying plots or stereotypes. My 3-6 year old children loved to ask questions about the kids in the pictures and learn about the animals gentle little adventures. These are precious little bits of sunshine on our bookshelf. Highly recommend.
