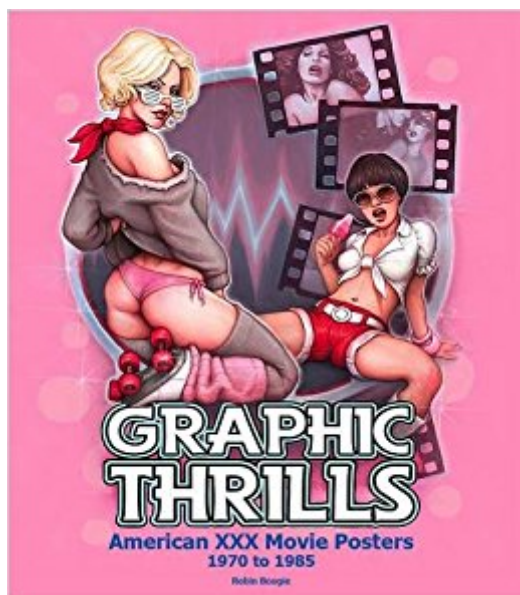

Robin Bougie began Cinema Sewer magazine, an ode to the seamier side of film and the culture which surrounds it, in 1997. The magazine found an audience amongst film fans looking for something totally different. FAB Press have been working alongside Bougie since 2009, and to date have published four volumes in the popular Cinema Sewer book series. Graphic Thrills is the latest result of this wildly successful creative collaboration.

This is the best book I have seen in the genre of adult movie posters from the "Golden Age" of XXX movies. This one, authored by Robin Bougie who is best known for his "Cinema Sewer" publications' is full of text, well-researched and written in a witty and very informative manner. The book is full of coloured plates of great adult movie posters and includes details of the films' release dates, actors, directors and where known, the posters' artists. No other books I have seen or own in the same vein as this one compare in its textual information. A great buy!

Robin Bougie has compiled a unique volume and provided a real service for adultmovie devotees. Those of us of That Certain Age who can recall seeing most if not all of the titles represented in this book on real theater screens of the 60's and 70's owe Bougie more than gratitude. Yes, the memories are certainly here, but there is more. There is the reinforcing of those beliefs (as if it were needed), that yet another Film genre was really that short-lived and is now also deeply buried. Film noir, Screwball comedies, hard boiled whodunits, high adventure romances, saddle-burning horse operas, and yes, hardcore XXX features with plots and ....actors. Those of you for whom this is your particular brand of Darjeeling know who you are, and are way ahead of me. For the rest, if you have even a gram of red Movie blood in you, why are you hesitating? Get this book. Now.
